

**Medical Maggots™** - Disinfected *Phaenicia* (=Lucilia) *sericata* larvae.

**Creature Comforts™** – Polyester net dressing to keep the maggots on the wound. Using adhesive glue and tape, bond to a hydrocolloid pad or other foundation on the skin to build a maggot cage around the wound.

**LeFlap™** (also known as "Creature Comforts II") – Dual-layered maggot cage dressing, with hydrocolloid layer and adhesive-lined polyester layer. No other dressings required except top gauze and perhaps extra tape or transparent membrane for added security if wound is over mobile or soil-prone anatomy.

**Hydrocolloid Pad.** Used to make custom maggot therapy dressings at the bedside. Simply cut a hole in the pad to match the wound shape, place remaining pad as a foundation around the wound, place the maggots on the wound bed, and glue your porous cover (i.e., Creature Comforts polyester net) to the hydrocolloid foundation.

**Adhesives** – Used to bond netting (i.e., Creature Comforts) to hydrocolloid or wound periphery.

**Transparent membrane dressings** – Used optionally to secure the maggot dressing to the skin, especially for wounds over areas prone to excessive movement (i.e., joints), perspiration or soiling (i.e., sacrum, coccyx).

	Transparent membrane dressings, approximately 2” x 3” (brand may vary).	Transparent membrane dressings, placed as a frame over the net-hydrocolloid bond and extending onto the peripheral skin, can make maggot dressings more durable in areas predisposed to soiling and loosening (i.e., wounds over sacrum, coccyx, joints).	\$0.85 each (\$69/100)

**Skin protective wipe** – Used optionally to protect the healthy skin around the wound from rash, maceration or damage from the adhesives and wound drainage (assorted brands).

**Reimbursement:** AMA and CMS recommend coding all of the maggot therapy dressings using CPT supply code 99070 (“Supplies and materials [except spectacles], provided by the physician over and above those usually included with the office visit or other services rendered”), and then listing each item. Of course, therapists and their institutions are ultimately responsible for selecting the appropriate billing codes, as dictated by the clinical indication, the procedure and supplies used, and the policies of third party payors.
